SHORT-TERM TRAINING PROGRAMS

CNC Machine Operator

Gain the expertise to work as a CNC Machine Operator. Learn how to set up and operate a variety of computer-controlled and mechanically-controlled machine tools to produce precision metal parts, instruments and tools. These tools include lathes, mills, routers and grinders.

Basic Welding

Work in the welding lab to learn skills to pass the welding test at area employers. The program includes 180 hours of welding plus 40 hours of additional training in math, measurement, blueprint reading, welding symbols and employability skills.

Certified Nursing Aide Training

Certified nurse aides provide basic care for patients in hospitals and residents of long-term care facilities. Learn more about EICC's hands-on training, including who hires CNAs in the surrounding area and potential funding sources to assist with tuition costs.
